

COVID 19 Policy Statement

Tullamore Union of Parishes is committed to providing safe and healthy places of worship for all our volunteers and parishioners. To ensure that, we have developed the following COVID-19 Response Plan. All volunteers are responsible for the implementation of this plan and a combined effort will help contain the spread of the virus.

We will:

1. continue to monitor our COVID-19 response and amend this plan in consultation with our volunteers
2. provide up to date information to our volunteers on the Public Health advice issued by the relevant authorities
3. display information on the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and correct hand-washing techniques
4. inform all volunteers of essential hygiene and respiratory etiquette and physical distancing requirements
5. adapt the church to facilitate physical distancing
6. keep a log of all attendees to help with contact tracing
7. have all volunteers attend an induction / familiarisation / briefing
8. develop a procedure to be followed in the event of someone showing symptoms of COVID19 while at church
9. provide instructions for volunteers to follow if they develop signs and symptoms of COVID-19 during church
- 10.intensify cleaning in line with government advice

All volunteers will be consulted on an ongoing basis and feedback is encouraged on any concerns, issues or suggestions.
